Part A. NISOA Regional Representatives

This form is to be used by NISOA regional representatives when reporting ejections for fighting or physical assault on a game official.

Regional representatives must contact by telephone, facsimile or electronic mail (e-mail) the athletics director of the ejected player's institution **within 48 hours** and inform him or her that a player(s) has been ejected for fighting or physical assault on a game official.

This form may be faxed or e-mailed to the athletics director to serve as notification, or must be mailed if the athletics director is contacted by phone.

Part B. Directors of Athletics

Please note that in accordance with the NCAA Men's and Women's Soccer Rules and Interpretations [Rules 12.2 (Direct Kick Offenses); 12.2.3 (Striking); 12.3 (Ejections); 12.6.1 (Fighting); 12.12 (Ejections and Player Eligibility); 12.12.2 (Fighting Ejections and Suspension); 12.13 (Assault on Referee)] the following penalties apply to players ejected for fighting or assaulting an official.

1. A player ejected for assaulting a game official will not compete in a minimum of the next three regularly scheduled games. Furthermore, card accumulation may lengthen the suspension. (Refer to Rule 12.11 Accumulated Cautions and Game Suspensions.)
2. A player ejected for fighting shall not compete in his or her team's next two regularly scheduled games, including tournament games and postseason games. If the offense occurs in the final game of the season, the player shall not compete in the first game of the postseason or the first game of next season if the team is not in postseason.
3. A player involved in a second fight or assault of an official during the same season will be ejected from the game and required to sit out the remainder of the season, including postseason games.
