General Liability Insurance for
NISOA Registered Members

Important information for NISOA members:



A major benefit of membership in NISOA is that each registered dues paying member is provided a general liability insurance coverage. This brochure will explain who is covered, outline the protection provided, and inform how to file a claim should the need occur.

Who is covered?

All intercollegiate and interscholastic soccer officials, assessors, assignors and instructors who are registered members of NISOA.

What activities are covered?

A liability insurance policy must clearly express the insurers intention to cover liability claims. The insurer will pay those sums that an insured is legally obligated to pay as damages because of Bodily Injury or Property Damage to which this policy applies. The insurer will have the right and duty to defend any lawsuit seeking those damages.

The NISOA policy covers the intercollegiate and interscholastic soccer official for those activities administered by the Association and/or its members while performing his/her duties as a soccer official in an organized league, including practice and games, and also in their related capacity in clinics and camps run by or at the request of The Association.

This coverage is excess over any other type of liability insurance an official has in place on his/her own. Coverage is Per Occurrence basis and is Underwritten by National Casualty Insurance Company, an A.M. Best "A+" rated carrier. Coverage term is from August 15, to August 15, and the policy may be renewed annually by the Association.

How do I file a claim?

In the unfortunate event that you are involved in a lawsuit or a legal claim is made against you, while you were officiating or acting on behalf of the Association, you must notify the insurance representative immediately. All documents and relative information should be forwarded to:

Filing a claim, continued:

The insurance carrier will receive notification and immediately respond to any suit seeking damages. The carrier will provide legal defense, even if a suit is groundless. The important thing to remember is that proper notification is a must and any incident that may cause potential loss and claim against the policy should be discussed immediately with Janice Briggs at Summit America.
